1. Work Diaries were handed out to teachers

3. The IQAC presented copies of DVV queries to all the criteria members involved in SSR preparation
4. As per IQAC instructions, on an assigned date, the concerned criteria members furnished responses to DVV queries regarding their criteria
5. The responses were further edited and refined by incorporating suggestions of the IQAC members
6. Response to DVV queries was submitted on 07/09/2021
