The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of St. Gregorios College collects feedback from students on curriculum related to their programmes through online and offline. A well designed and structured questionnaire has been used to collect the response of students.

Objectives of the feedback

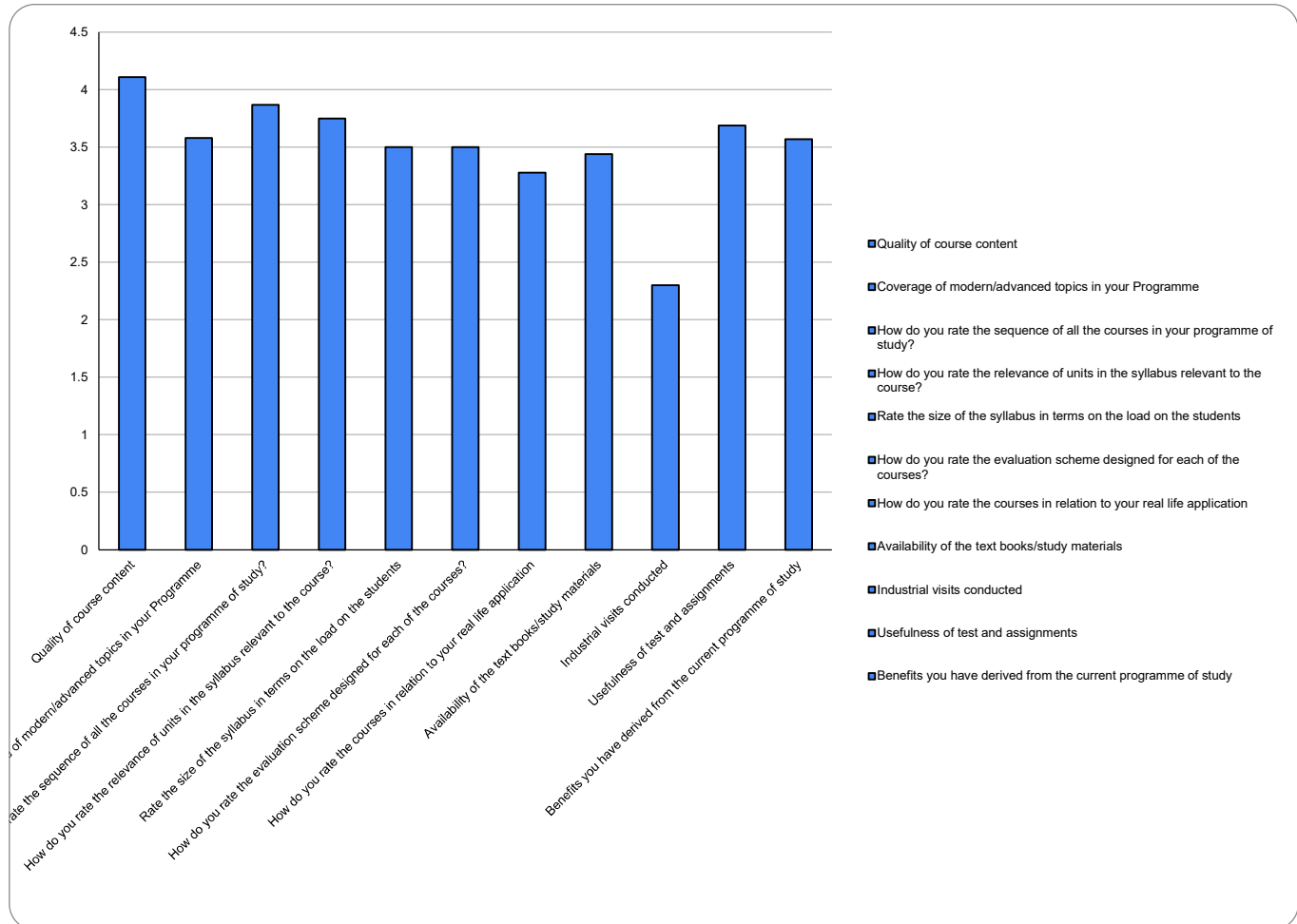
The objective of the feedback survey is to analyze the relevance and importance of the curriculum, and to assess how far it has attained the objective of satisfying the need of the academic community. The structured questionnaire includes questions related to various aspects of curriculum which are highly relevant to students. The parameters include questions related to the quality of the course content, effectiveness of the internal evaluation process, students' opportunities in participating industrial visits. The students' feedback on curriculum is collected through structured questionnaire and quantified and analyzed using a five point scale. Analysis of the collected data and the findings are given below.

Interpretation:

The mean score of all the eleven questions/statements under consideration for the students' feedback of 2017-18 was 3.51 out 5. The quality of the course content in the college was the most attractive factor for students which gained a mean score of 4.11. The least satisfying factor under curriculum as far as the students were concerned was the industrial visits conducted for the students, which earned a mean score of 2.30. However, all the factors determining the satisfaction of students on curriculum showed gradual improvements over the years.
