Objectives of the Feedback

The feedback survey's goal was to assess the curriculum's relevance and importance, as well as how much it had progressed in meeting the needs of the scholarly institution. The structured questionnaire comprises questions about various aspects of the curriculum that are extremely important to students. The survey contains questions about the efficacy of learning resources in the college, the efficiency of the internal assessment process, the relevance of curriculum, including industrial visits, the role of curriculum in enhancing creativeness and discovering new ideas and contents, and the objectives.

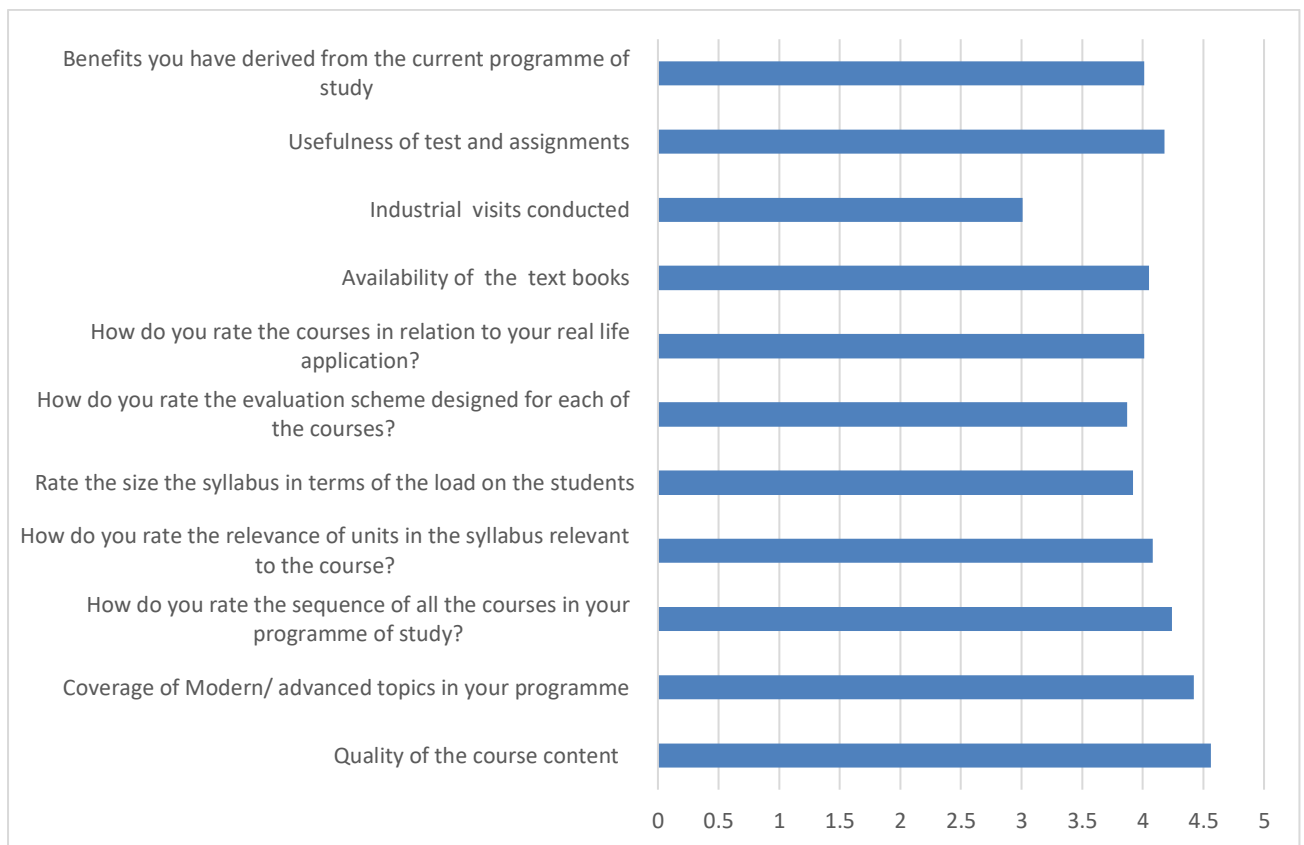
About the Survey

Interpretation

The mean score for all the eleven statements considered for 2020-2021 student feedback was 4.03 out of 5. The most appealing factor for students was the quality of the course content in the college, which received a mean score of 4.56, while the relevance of units in the syllabus and the sequence of the courses received 4.42 and 4.24 respectively. The least satisfying aspect of the curriculum, according to the students, was the industrial visits, which received a mean score of 3.01.
