About the Survey and its Objective

The purpose of the feedback survey was to evaluate the curriculum's importance and relevance as well as how far it had come in addressing the requirements of the academic institution. The structured questionnaire includes inquiries about a number of curriculum topics that are very significant to students. The survey asks questions about the effectiveness of the college's learning resources, the efficiency of the internal assessment process, the relevance of the curriculum, including the value of industrial visits, and how the curriculum fosters creativity and leads to the discovery of new concepts and ideas.

Interpretation

The overall average for the eleven statements that were evaluated for the 2021–2022 student feedback was 4.06 out of 5. The quality of the course content at the college received a mean score of 4.45 from students, while the relevance of the syllabus's units and the usefulness of tests and assignments received 4.35 and 4.28, respectively. The industrial visits received a mean score of 3.00 from the students and were rated as the least enjoyable part of the curriculum.




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
